
A PLOT OF THE WELCH GRANT.

South Carolina. By write of Precept to me directed by James II. Johns, Esq. His Najertys Surveyor General, bearing date the Sixteenth of November, 1736. I have admeasured and laid out for the Wilch families that are to be Imported to this Province, a Tract of Land containing in the whole One Kundred and Seventy three.—I housand, Eight Handred and Lorty Acrs., shuated and being in Groven County, Im Thousand Acrs., being part thereof Lying within the limits of the Tomiship of Queenborough on the North side of Pidee River, the Ronainder of Said Tract lying on both sides of said River, Butting & Bounding to the South East on the Reserved Lands of the said Tomiship of Queensborough and all other sides on vascant Lands as is supposed, a hath such shape, form and marks os are Expresented by this Deliniated Plot, thereof given under my hand, 29 th Day of November, 1736. per me, (Signed)
